COVID-19 Vaccination update

The delivery of the COVID-19 vaccine to all RCH residents is finally underway with residents at Hope Valley receiving their first jab (after an aborted first attempt) on Friday 9th April with 76 residents and 23 staff being vaccinated. The Hope Valley residents and staff will have their second jab on 30th April.

We have just received confirmation that Glynde RCH residents will receive their first jab during the week commencing 17th May with the exact date and time to be confirmed.

We are aware that some residents and family members have concerns with the possible side effects of having the vaccine.

The very clear message from our key health officials both state and federal is that we need to encourage everyone to get vaccinated – if not for themselves, then for the sake of those residents within our community who are aged over 70 and more likely to experience serious health issues and possibly die if they contract the Coronavirus.
